



365nm 12 LED Ultraviolet Flashlight

Safety Warnings & Operating Instructions

Read this manual carefully before using your new flashlight. The flashlight is not a toy. It must not be stored or operated within the reach of children.

For material or personal damage caused by improper handling or failure to observe these operating instructions, we assume no liability! In such cases the warranty is voided.

WARNINGS:



The product you have purchased from Americans' Preferred® is a 12 LED Ultraviolet flashlight with a wavelength ranging 365-370nm. In this UV range the eyelid closure reflex is not working. Therefore, under any circumstances during the operation on the UV LED, don't point the beam to the eyes! It's recommended to always use suitable UV filters or goggles according CE EN166 in order to avoid eye damage. Also, avoid prolonged exposure of the skin or other tissue.

Keep UV LEDs always out of reach of children and avoid the operation of the UV-LED when children are near!

- Never leave the LED flashlight to non-trained persons or children unattended.
- Within the cone of light, you can not use optics for focusing the light beam.
- The LEDs are not interchangeable. Please do not try to remove or change them.


BATTERY WARNINGS:

- Do not leave batteries on children's hands!
- Do not use batteries of different types!
- Do not mix old and new batteries together!
- Remove the batteries when not using the flashlight for extended periods of time!
- Clean battery and device contacts before inserting, if necessary.
- Ensure that the device is switched off after use.

Leaking or damaged batteries can cause burns on contact with skin, therefore use suitable protective gloves. In case of contact with battery acid, rinse the affected areas immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention immediately. Make sure that the batteries are not short-circuited or thrown into fire. Do not try to recharge the batteries unless they are "Rechargeable batteries".



WASTE DISPOSAL:



Do not dispose the batteries together with the household waste! Electronic devices must be disposed of in accordance with the Directive on waste electrical and electronic devices via the local collecting point for old electronic devices!

Contaminated batteries / rechargeable batteries are labeled with these symbols to indicate that it is prohibited to dispose them with your household waste. The designations for the decisive heavy metals are: Cd = cadmium, Hg = mercury, Pb = lead (name on battery / rechargeable battery, i.e. as shown on the bin icons on the left).

Dispose your used batteries / accumulators for free at collection facilities in your community or everywhere where batteries / accumulators are sold!

BATTERY INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:




The flashlight operates with three AAA batteries (INCLUDED).

To insert the batteries, follow these steps:

- 1. Unscrew the tail cap and slide out the battery tray by tilting the flashlight,
- 2. Insert each battery with the negative pole always facing the spring,



3. Slide the battery tray back into the flashlight body with the positive side facing the LEDs side. You will find the '+' sign on the battery tray stamped on the metal edge. Incorrect installation of battery tray may cause damages to the lamp!



4. Screw back the tail cap and it will be ready to use.



OPERATION:

To start using your flashlight, press on the tail cap switch to turn it on and off.
